EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE HONORABLE FRANKLIN M. DRILON, SENATOR, REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES TO ALLOCATE ADDITIONAL SLOTS OF TESDA SCHOLARS AT THE BULALACAO TECHNICAL AND VOCATIONAL COLLEGE, MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO

“WHEREAS, in a rapidly globalizing economy, providing basic education is simply not enough that one must have a specific and marketable skills in order to enter and benefit from the formal labor market here and abroad;

“WHEREAS, there is no tertiary school found in the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro that the Municipal Government took the initiative of establishing the Bulalacao Technical and Vocational College (BTVC) where young secondary school graduates may enroll and take the necessary training and skills in welding;

“WHEREAS, despite of the new established BTVC still, many families of this Pro-Poor Municipality do not have sufficient resources to sustain their children in school that this Body is seeking financial assistance from other government agencies to help those who are interested in vocational courses offered by the BTVC;

“WHEREAS, it shall be of great benefits from our less fortunate brothers and sisters if they shall be given enough opportunities for a vocational courses to enable them to be employed in a rapidly growing industries and earn more than a subsistence wages; Now, therefore, be it






